**Howe Sound Women's Centre Society Receives \$25,000 Commitment  
To Fund Girl's Summer Day Camps Over Next Five Years**

SQUAMISH, BC (October 12, 2016) Howe Sound Women's Centre Society is pleased to announce private funder Vankerk Solutions will be providing financial support for the annual Girl's Summer Day Camps in Squamish and Whistler for the next five years. Vankerk Solutions has committed \$5,000/year for the next five years to cover the operational cost of the camp and ensure access for families in need. The Girl's Summer Day Camps are focused on connecting with nature, building friendships and empowerment for young girls aged 8 – 11.

"The Girl's Summer Day Camps provide a safe, supported environment for self-expression and self-care, and this is something that really resonates for me," says Niki Vankerk, principal of Vankerk Solutions. "When young girls engage in activities they wouldn't normally do, it encourages them to see beyond limitations and feel empowered to pursue their dreams."

The two Girl's Summer Day Camps run for five consecutive days in Squamish and Whistler in July of each year. The camps include a significant amount of time spent in nature: playing, hiking, doing nature art, and creating shared experiences that foster healthy relationships. The goal of the camps is to counter the reduction in self-esteem experienced by young girls as they enter their teenage years. The week-long camps cost \$195/person, with subsidies available to those in need.

"This program is near and dear to the hearts of our staff," says Megan Reynolds, executive director with Howe Sound Women's Centre Society. "Yet year after year, we are faced with the challenge of finding the resources to make it happen. To be able to look ahead to the next five years and know, without a doubt, that the Girl's Summer Day Camps are an inherent part of our programming, is just so exciting for us. We hope that through the friendships and community connections made, these young women grow up to know we are here to support them, no matter what challenges may come."

Funding for the first year of the Girl's Summer Day Camps was matched by private donor Clasina van Bommel as part of Howe Sound Women's Centre Society's 35 Day Community Fundraising Challenge.
